The play's title refers to the psychiatric condition *folie* à *deux* or induced psychosis - a paranoid delusional system which appears to develop in a person as a result of a close relationship with another person who already has an established and similar delusional system.

Last seen as Eunice in Streetcar Named Desire, this evening she plays Colleen, the most sensible of the three women in Folie à Trois. During the day Zuzana, looking a little less haggard and a little more stylish, tries to instill a love of mathematics into students in the International School.







Amy Wilson is originally from Leeds in the UK and moved to Basel in August 2007. Amy has been involved in various amateur dramatic productions in the UK over the past 20 years and has won several awards in dance and theatre. This is Amy's first production with Semi-Circle.

Meier-Bradlin Nina

Nina Meier-Bradlin is an actress and singer who was born in Detroit, Michigan. She attended Cranbrook Theatre School as a teen and continued her training at the University of Michigan. In Basel, Nina was a Semi-Circle regular in the 90s, as an actress as well as a director. After a long hiatus, she co-directed Joseph and the Technicolor Dreamcoat in 2005 and sparred with Prospero in Upstart Entertainment's production of Return to the Forbidden Planet as Gloria in 2006. She was Stuck on the stage of the Schönes Haus in 2007 with the Gay Beggars. Nina was thrilled to have the chance to revive her portrayal of Blanche DuBois in A Streetcar Named Desire (Semi-Circle, November 2008) for an additional performance at the Komediateatteri Arena theatre in Helsinki, Finland in March this year. Nina would like to thank Aidan McGarry for his accent coaching for the role of Ellen.

Fliss Wright started acting at an early age in local pantomime and school productions. At university her credits included Our Country's Good, Jack the Ripper and (Sunday is) the New Saturday (Edinburgh Festival Fringe). Fliss then studied acting and musical theatre at Central School of Speech and Drama where she realised that her skills were better suited to working off-stage rather than on! She spent several years working in the theatre industry in London before moving to Basel in March 2008. Fliss played Flash Charming in Cinderella - Lost in Space with Basel's English Panto. This is her first role with Semi-Circle.







Maiwald Marieluise

Although she has been in a number of Semi-Circle shows and pantos before, this is Marieluise's first experience of a full-female cast (and producer). "I would never have imagined how relaxed the atmosphere could be, once we had all had a few sips of Conny's delicious white wine and started to discuss how sexy we thought Trevor was, the American vs. British pronunciation of 'corset' and whether or not Ellen should wear a garter in the opening scene..."



Penny Rettig

Penny started her amateur dramatic career in Southern Africa, working backstage before finally taking the plunge and actually acting. She has been a member of Semi-Circle for five years, beginning with offering to 'help' backstage during *Oliver*, only to find herself as Stage Manager. She has been involved in some way with most productions since. Stage roles have included Lotte in *Lettice & Lovage*, a pantomime witch and a fairy, and she was most recently on stage as the 'mother-in-law from hell' in Alan Ayckbourne's *Roleplay*. Please do not send any tailoring or alterations to her, as unlike Phyllis, she is severely challenged by sewing on buttons!

Born in Chile, Vinka grew up in Norway where at the age of five she had her first role in the theatre as a tree in a haunted forest. Smitten by love for the stage she has since then been in different free theatre groups touring in Norway. She has studied history, marketing and, in the University of Oslo, restarted studying interpersonal relationships. Love brought her to Switzerland where she has in the past five years acted in The English Drama Group of the University of Zurich. This is her first role as a member of the Semi-Circle.

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


